Artists who live and/or work in the Northfield area (including Northfield, Roxbury, Brookfield, Braintree, Williamstown and Berlin) are invited to exhibit their works at the Virtual Northfield Arts Show. Students of Northfield High School and Norwich University are encouraged to participate.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORMS and Photos:
January 1, 2021

WORKS ELIGIBLE: All entries must be original (i.e., no kits, paint-by-number, copies, etc.) 2 or 3-dimensional art work in the following categories: oils and acrylics, watercolors, pastels, pencil, pulled prints, fiber art, sculpture, stained glass, fine woodworking, ceramics, photography and metal work including jewelry. The committee reserves the right to refuse work deemed to be inappropriate. Artists may submit between 1 and 20 photographs of pieces for the show.

All works that will be included in the show must be photographed, with price visible if for sale, and emailed to Adam Evans at adamlouis.evans@gmail.com

ARTISTS' BIO: All participating artists are requested to write a brief biography of their journey to making art including a photo of the artist, preferably working. Statements of a few to several sentences may include education, current and past career, goals, etc. Statements will be linked to artists' work. SALE OF EXHIBITED ITEMS: Art work exhibited in the show that is for sale should have price visible in the photograph of the work. If no price is

visible it will be assumed that the piece is not for sale. ***Individuals interested in purchasing artwork will contact the artist directly and make arrangements for payment and pick up.***
